Total Assessed value decreased about 3 percent countywide for 2009. For tax year 2010, over 51 percent of the taxpayers will be paying less in property tax than they paid in 2009. Approximately 75 percent of the taxpayers will be paying less or from just a few cents to no more than \$50 than the previous year.
