

## If you do not follow directions carefully some of your votes may not count.

- You must vote for candidates of one political party only and then vote nonpartisan races and issues,  
or  
you can vote nonpartisan races and issues only.
- Your privacy is protected. No record of the political party you select will be made.

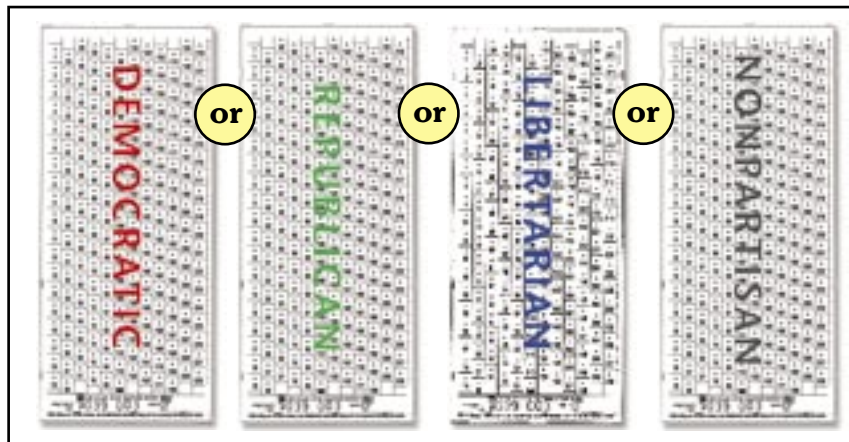
- Nonpartisan: Not associated with any political party.
- Primary: In the Primary you nominate candidates who will run in the General Election in November.

## WASHINGTON STATE HAS A NEW PRIMARY

### WARNING!

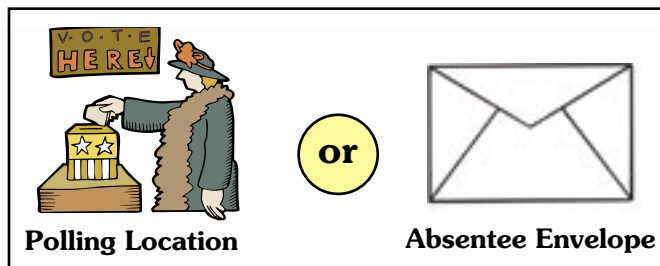
To have your vote counted for party candidates you must complete a two (2) step process. First, select one (1) party ballot. Second, vote only for the candidates of that party. Votes for nonpartisan races will be counted regardless of which ballot you select.

**1** You must choose one (1) of four (4) ballots.



**2** Vote one (1) of four (4) ballots.  
Votes for Nonpartisan races and issues may be cast on any ballot regardless of party affiliation.

**3** Turn in one (1) ballot.



**4** Destroy and recycle or discard the other three (3) ballots.
