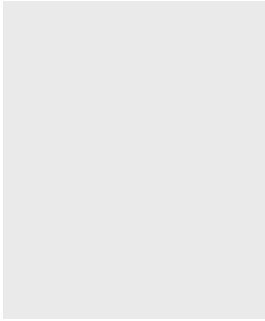
### Jim McCune

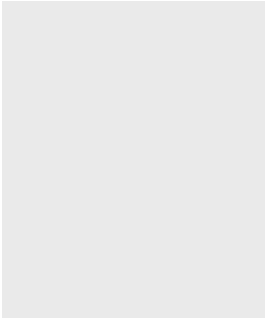
### **Gary Alexander**

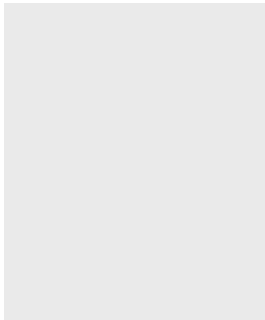

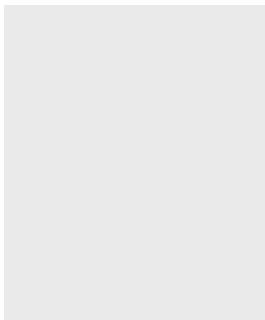
