

# Voting By Mail: Q & A

**Q – What do I do if I lose my ballot?**

**A –** Call the Thurston County Auditor's Office at (360)786-5408, or stop by and pick up a replacement ballot at 2000 Lakeridge Drive SW, Olympia, building one. Replacement ballots are available until 8:00 p.m. on election day.

**Q – What happens if I forget to sign my ballot?**

**A –** First, we will attempt to contact you by phone. Additionally, we will send you a letter with a ballot oath to sign and return before certification. If we can verify your signature, your ballot will be counted.

**Q – What if my signature has changed since I registered, and I am not sure if it will match?**

**A –** To update your signature with the Auditor's Office you must fill out a new registration form. The form is available on page 41. You can come in to our office and fill out the form in person or you can mail in the form. We will call you if there are any issues with matching your signature.

**Q – What if I am unable to sign my ballot?**

**A –** If you can make a mark of any kind, you may have two witnesses sign the voter's affidavit on the mailing envelope to attest to the validity of your mark.
