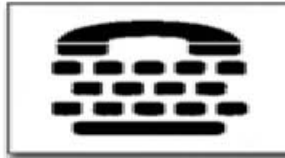

What is the AutoMARK™?

The AutoMARK™ is a voting assistance machine that enables voters who cannot otherwise read or mark their ballots to vote independently and secretly. Voters with visual impairments, cognitive or learning disabilities, illiteracy issues, or mobility impairments can use the machine to have their ballots read to them, magnify the print on the ballots, display the ballots in high contrast, and mark their ballots. The machine does not produce a ballot.
