

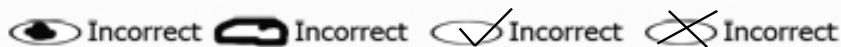
Thurston County Sample Ballot

This sample ballot contains all candidates and ballot measures certified to appear on the November 3, 2009 General Election ballot. Be sure to follow all instructions on your regular ballot. How To Mark Your Ballot



Fill in the oval to the left of your desired selection. Use a dark ink pen. Do not use a pencil or gel pen.



If You Make A Mistake

George Washington
(This vote will not be counted)

Thomas Jefferson
(This vote will be counted)

Do not erase any selection made in error. If you make a mistake, draw a line through the entire candidate's name.

If you wish to vote for another candidate, fill in the oval to the left of your chosen candidate.

More than one vote for an office or measure will be an overvote, and no votes for that office or measure will be counted. You do not have to vote in every race.

Write-in Votes: To vote for a person not on the ballot, write the name on the line provided, then fill in the oval to the left of the write-in line.

Return Your Ballot: Follow the instructions on the envelopes and colored insert. Remember to sign and date the voter's affidavit on the return envelope.

Initiative Measure No. 1033 concerns state, county and city revenue. This measure would limit growth of certain state, county and city revenue to annual inflation and population growth, not including voter-approved revenue increases. Referendum Measure No. 71

The legislature passed Engrossed Second Substitute Senate Bill 5688 concerning rights and responsibilities of state-registered domestic partners and voters have filed a sufficient referendum petition on this bill. This bill would expand the rights, responsibilities, and obligations accorded state-registered same-sex and senior domestic partners to be equivalent to those of married spouses, except that a domestic partnership is not a marriage.

| The Board of Commissioners of Thurston County Fire Protection District No. 7 adopted Resolution No. 09-03=R1 concerning a proposition to restore the District's regular property tax levy. The proposition would authorize the District to restore its 2009 regular property tax levy to \$1.00 per \$1,000 of assessed value for collection in 2010 to finance maintenance, operations, and capital facilities and would authorize setting a 1% limit factor for each of the five succeeding years and provide that the maximum allowable levy in 2015 shall be used to determine future increases as allowed by Chapter 84.55 RCW. |
