times.

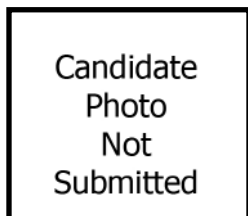

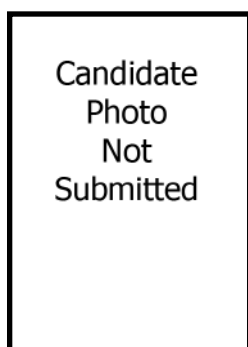
