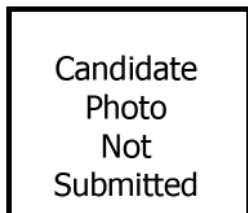
I am grateful to have the opportunity to serve this community and would be honored to continue serving as your Mayor.
