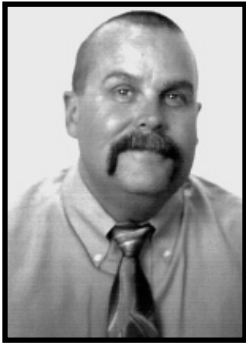

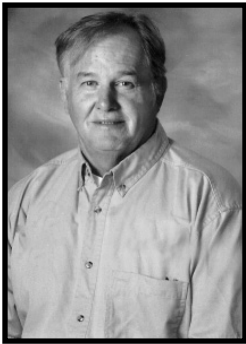

Olympia Fire District #6 and its citizens.

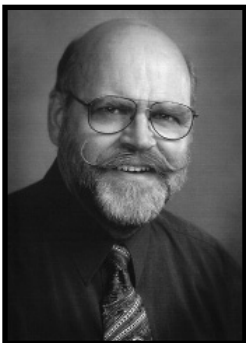
