

Additional Candidate Information

Thurston County Local Voters' Pamphlet

Statement Guidelines

- 150 words maximum (hand counted, two words combined with a hyphen will count as two)
- No more than 4 paragraphs; the statement must fit in the space allotted on the pamphlet page. Candidates will be notified if their statement exceeds the space allotment.
- Lists, bullets, or other items requiring multiple hard returns will be typeset in paragraph form with semi-colon separations.
- No bold type. Bold type will be changed to italics.
- Statement must pertain to the candidate only and may not contain endorsements.
- Phone, address & email will be included without counting against the 150 word maximum.

Photo Guidelines

- Photo must be no more than 5 years old.
- Black and white is preferred, but is not required.
- Photo must be of head and shoulders of candidate.
- Photos may be cropped at the auditor's discretion to ensure consistency throughout the pamphlet.
- Hard copy photos must be no smaller than 3x5 inches.

Submission Guidelines

- Emailed statements and photos are preferred. They must be sent to pamphlet@co.thurston.wa.us
- Candidates who email statements and/or photos will receive a confirmation email. It is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure his or her statement and photo have been received.
- Statements and photos will be discussed with the candidate only.
- Statements and photos may be submitted on disk or hard copy, and may be dropped off at the auditor's office.

June 11, 2007 - Primary pamphlet

August 2, 2007 - General pamphlet

Candidates appearing in the Primary Election pamphlet have until August 27 to submit their revised statement for publication in the General Election pamphlet.

Filing Information

Filing Fees: determined by RCW 29A.24.091
 No Salary No Fee
 \$1,000 or less \$10.00
 More than \$1,000 1% of Salary
No refunds per RCW 29A.24.131

Indigent Filing Fee:

A candidate who lacks sufficient assets or income at the time of filing to pay the filing fee required by law shall submit with his or her Declaration of Candidacy a filing fee petition. The petition shall contain not less than a number of signatures of registered voters equal to the number of dollars of the filing fee. The signatures shall be of voters registered to vote within the jurisdiction of the office for which the candidate is filing. (RCW 29A.24.091)

Filing Withdrawal Dates:

Any candidate may withdraw in writing before the close of business on Thursday, June 14. (RCW 29A.24.131)

Candidate Order Determined by Lot Drawing:

June 8 - 5:00 p.m., auditor's office. Selection of ballot order by lot for all candidates. (RCW 29A.36.131)
