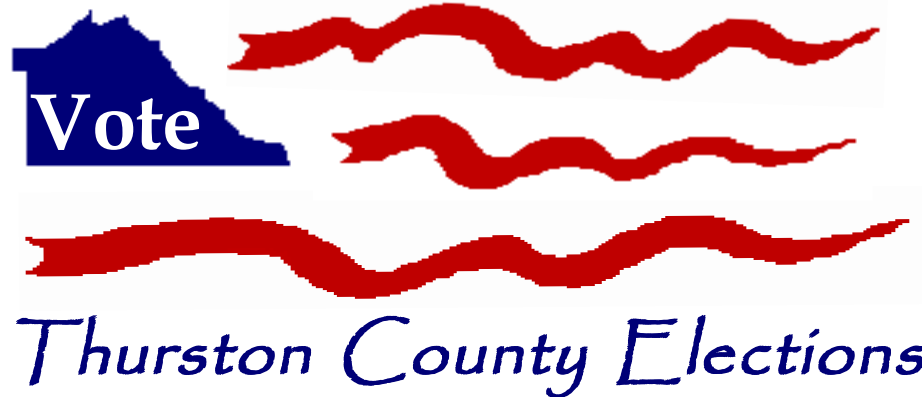

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR FILING

All candidates must reside in the district and be a registered voter at the time of filing. (RCW 29A.20.020)

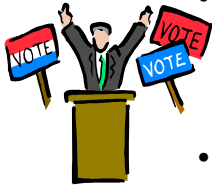
INDIGENT FILING FEE

A candidate who lacks sufficient assets or income at the time of filing to pay the filing fee required by law, shall submit with his or her Declaration of Candidacy a nominating petition. The petition shall contain not less than a number of signatures of registered voters equal to the number of dollars of the filing fee. The signatures shall be of voters registered to vote within the jurisdiction of the office for which the candidate is filing. (RCW 29A.24.090)

The information contained in this calendar may change due to new legislation, judicial determination, or incumbent resignations.

FILING INFORMATION



- **FILING DATES:**
July 25 - 29 (RCW 29A.24.050)
By mail, notarized with filing fee:
July 11 - 29 (RCW 29A.24.080)
- **FILING WITHDRAWAL DATES:**
Any candidate may withdraw in writing before July 28 or later if Primary ballots have not been ordered. (RCW 29A.24.130)
- **LOCATIONS FOR FILING FOR OFFICE:**
All offices file at the Auditor's Office except where it is noted below the name of the district. (RCW 29A.24.070)
- **FILING FEE:** No refunds (RCW 29A.24.090,130)
No salary - No fee; \$1,000 or less - \$10.00;
\$1,000 or more - 1% of annual salary.
- **WRITE-IN CANDIDATES:** (RCW 29A.24.310)
Candidates must pay a filing fee at the time of filing.
- **SELECTION OF CANDIDATES BY LOT:**
July 29 - 5:00 P.M., Elections Dept. Candidate order for ballots. (RCW 29A.36.120,130)
- **VACANCIES - NON-PARTISAN:**
If no one files for a position during both the normal filing period and a three-day special filing period, that position is left off the fall ballots. The incumbent will remain in office until a successor is elected at the next election when such positions are voted upon. RCW 29A.24.200, 51.240)
(For vacancies - partisan offices, see RCW 29A.28.010)
- **VOTERS PAMPHLET:**
Having your Voters Pamphlet statement ready at the time of filing saves you time and energy in the future, as well as making our lives easier. Statements are actually due for individuals involved in the Primary, on August 1, 2005.

PRIMARY ELECTION BALLOT

- **Non-Partisan:** Three or more candidates must file for a position to be on the Primary ballot. (RCW 29A.52.220, 010)
Names appear on the ballot by lot. (RCW 29A.36.130)
- **Partisan:** The top two candidates must receive at least 1% of the total votes cast for that office in order to appear on the General Election ballot. Additionally, Partisan candidates must have a plurality of votes cast for their party for the office sought. (RCW 29A.36.170, 190)

GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT

Order of Appearance on Ballot

Non-Partisan: Names appear by most votes received. If no Primary was held name selection will be by lot.
(RCW 29A.36.170; 130)

Partisan: Candidates will appear in the following order:
Democrat, Republican, Libertarian and
all minor party candidates. (RCW 29A.36.160)
