Thurston Conservation District Seeking Board of Supervisor Candidates

The Thurston Conservation District Board of Supervisors is seeking candidates among Thurston County residents that are interested in serving the people of Thurston County as a volunteer Conservation District Supervisor. There is one elected (Position #1) and one appointed position (Position #1) open to applicants at this time.

These positions are part of a volunteer five-person Board of Supervisors, who serve without compensation. The Board is responsible for setting and maintaining overall district policies and programs regarding the management and conservation of natural resources within the district. Nominees must be registered voters and a Thurston County landowner or operator of a farm within the Thurston Conservation District boundaries.

Candidate information and nominations are due at the District Office by January 31, 2012 at 4:30 pm. The election is scheduled for Saturday, February 25, 2012 from 10 am – 2 pm at the Thurston Conservation District office, located at 2918 Ferguson St. SW, Tumwater. Absentee ballots will be available February 1 – February 22nd at 4:30 pm by contacting the District Office. All absentee ballots must be received by the Thurston County Elections Office no later than 5:00 pm, Friday February 24, 2012.
