### **Ballots Available and Countywide Ballot Drop Boxes Open for February 14, 2012 Special Election**

OLYMPIA – Ballots will be available on Wednesday, January 25, 2012 at the Thurston County Auditor's Office, 2000 Lakeridge Dr. SW, Building 1, Room 106, Olympia, WA for the February 14, 2012 Special Election. All voters in Thurston County will receive a ballot, which should arrive in homes by Saturday or Monday, January 28 or 30. If you have not received a ballot by February 7 contact the Thurston County Auditor's Office at (360) 786-5408, or come to the Auditor's Office for a replacement ballot.

Thurston County's 25 secure ballot drop boxes are open on January 25. There is a change in the location of the downtown Olympia Fire Station 1 drop box, 100 Eastside St NE, which has been moved around the corner, to the front of Crain's Office Supply at 1006 4<sup>th</sup> Ave E. Boxes are open 24 hours a day and close promptly at 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 14, Election Night. No stamp is necessary when using one of the 25 drop boxes.
