

**OFFICIAL NOTICE OF
THURSTON COUNTY GENERAL ELECTION**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Tuesday, the 8th day of November, 2011, a General Election will be conducted entirely by mail in all of Thurston County. If you return your ballot by mail, first class postage is required. Ballots must be postmarked by the day of the election. Check with your local post office for deadlines to have your ballot properly postmarked. However, no postage is required if you deposit your ballot in an open ballot drop box by 8:00 p.m. Election Night.

Voter Registration Deadlines: The registration deadline for online registrations, mail-in registrations and transfers for the November 8, 2011 General Election is Monday, October 10, 2011. If you are not currently registered in Washington State you may register in person at the Auditor's Office, 2000 Lakeridge Dr SW, Bldg. One, Rm.106, Olympia, WA 98502 by the end of the business day, Monday, October 31, 2011.

The purpose of these meetings is to canvass ballots for the November 8, 2011 General Election. The canvass board meetings are open public meetings, and shall be continued until the activity for which the meetings are held has been completed.
