Local Voters' Pamphlet to be Delivered to Homes

OLYMPIA – On October 13 the Thurston County Local Voters' Pamphlet for the November 8 General Election will start arriving at homes throughout Thurston County. Auditor Kim Wyman notes, "Voters throughout the county will be voting on a Port of Olympia Commissioner and, depending on where you live, you may have city or town council, mayor, school board director, fire commissioner, park and recreation commissioner, or cemetery district commissioner candidates on your ballot. The pamphlet also includes information on three local ballot measures for those voters who live within the City of Olympia or Fire Districts 3 (Lacey) or 8 (South Bay)".
