Ballots Available and Countywide Ballot Drop Boxes Open for November 8, 2011 General Election

OLYMPIA – Ballots will be available on Wednesday, October 19, 2011 at the Thurston County Auditor's Office, 2000 Lakeridge Dr. SW, Building 1, Room 106, Olympia, WA for the November 8, 2011 General Election. All voters in Thurston County will receive a ballot, which should arrive in homes by Thursday or Friday, October 20 or 21. If you have not received a ballot by October 26 contact the Thurston County Auditor's Office at (360) 786-5408, or come to the Auditor's Office for a replacement ballot.

The Auditor's Office will open all 25 of their secure ballot drop boxes on October 19. A list of drop box locations is included in your ballot materials, in the Local Voters' Pamphlet, and online at www.ThurstonVotes.org. Boxes are open 24 hours a day and close promptly at 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 8, Election Night. "The boxes allow voters an opportunity to return their ballot any time between now and 8:00 p.m. on Election Night at locations convenient to them without the need for postage," explained Auditor Kim Wyman.
