November 8, 2011 General Election

OLYMPIA – The Thurston County Auditor's Office wants to remind voters to return their ballots for the General Election by November 8, 2011. If you are mailing your ballot, please allow extra time for your ballot to be postmarked by Election Day. Ballots mailed later than Saturday, November 5, 2011 may not be postmarked in time.

To avoid a late postmark, Auditor Kim Wyman suggests Thurston County voters use one of the 25 drop boxes located throughout the county. No postage is required if you deposit your ballot in one of these secure drop boxes. A list of the drop boxes is included with your ballot material. The drop boxes are open 24 hours a day and close promptly at 8:00 p.m. on Election Night, Tuesday, November 8, 2011.

The Thurston County Auditor's Office is a designated Voting Center and voters can obtain a replacement ballot or use the AutoMARK™ voting machine if they need assistance voting their ballot. The Thurston County Auditor's Office is located at 2000 Lakeridge Dr SW, Building One, Room 106 in Olympia. On Election Day the Auditor's Office will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.
