

Accessibility Voting - Use of the AutoMARK™

The AutoMARK™ is a voting assistance machine that enables voters who cannot otherwise read or mark their ballots to vote independently and secretly.

Assists voters with: visual impairments, cognitive/learning disabilities, illiteracy and/or limited mobility.

The AutoMARK™: reads the ballot, magnifies the print, displays in high contrast, and marks the ballots.



The AutoMARK™ will be available at the Thurston County Courthouse, Auditor's Office, 2000 Lakeridge Dr SW, Olympia during regular business hours starting January 20, 2010. On Election Day, February 9, the Auditor's Office will be open 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
