## SECURITY ENVELOPE

### Make your vote count

- Do not make any identifying marks, signatures, or comments on your ballot or on this envelope.
- Insert ONE voted ballot in this envelope, seal and place in your Return Envelope.
- Read and sign the Voter's Affidavit on the Return Envelope, then seal the envelope.
- To return ballot by mail, place a first class stamp on the Return Envelope. Mail on or before Election Day.

OR

- Save the stamp—use our convenient drop boxes located at the county courthouse and at locations throughout the county by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
