

Please Attend a Community Forum-

Three special community forums are being held as part of the “Citizen Priorities for Thurston County Government” study. The meetings will feature a discussion of the results of a survey of 600 county residents. The forums will focus on understanding what a cross-section of citizens expressed as their priorities and how those priorities relate to the county budget for programs and services.

A research team from Washington State University will present information on the survey and help to lead the subsequent discussions. The forums will be an important part of the overall study because of the information sharing and discussion that will take place.

Thurston County Commissioners will use the survey results and forum discussions to plan for the service needs of county residents in 2006 and subsequent years.
