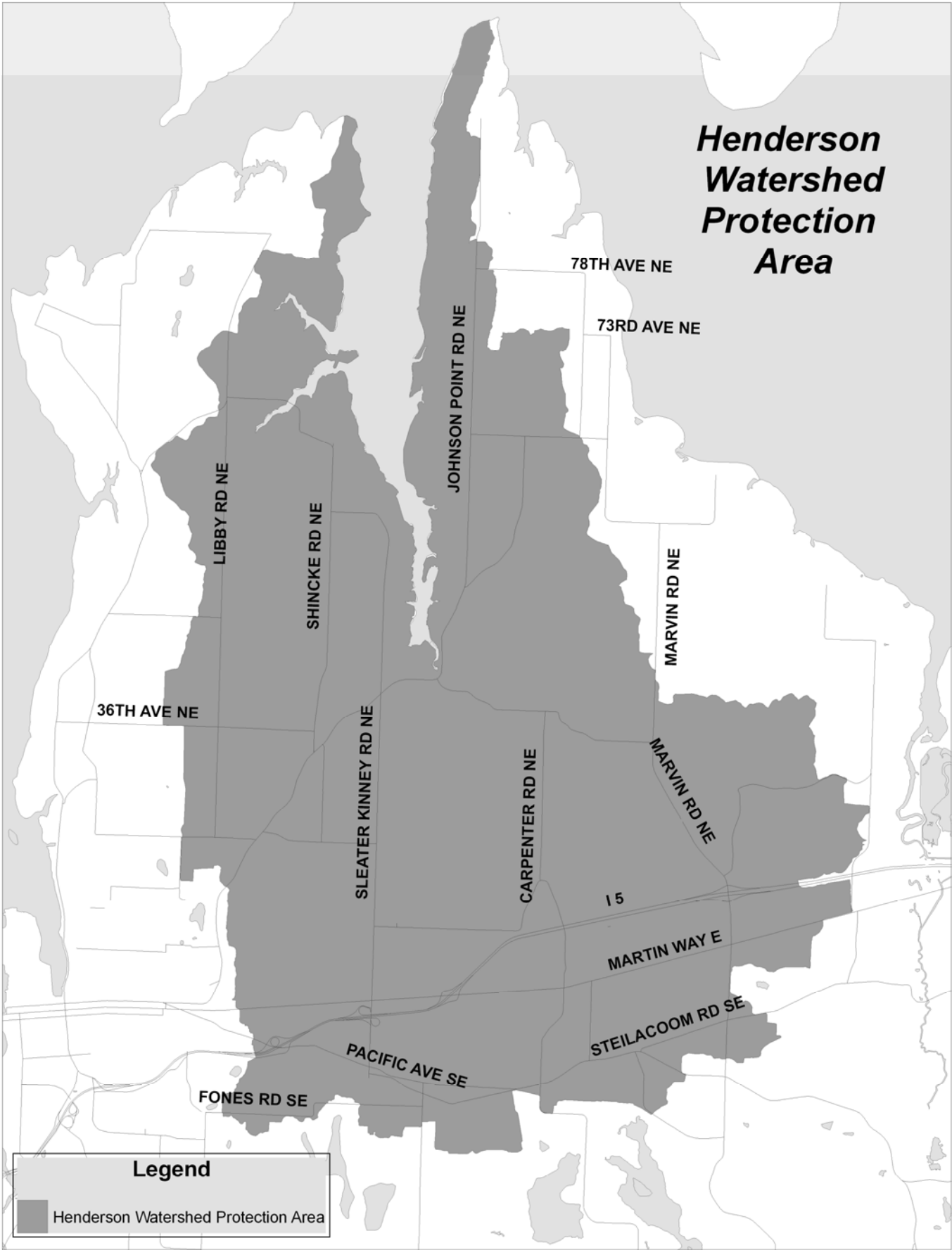



Henderson Watershed Protection Area

 Henderson Watershed Protection Area

Determine if a parcel of land is IN or OUT of the Henderson Watershed Protection Area (HWPB).

Important Note: If your browser has "pop-up" blocking software, you must disable this software to use the Thurston Geodata Center.

1. In the Address (URL) box of the browser type in www.geodata.org and click "go." In a search engines search box, type in www.geodata.org and click "go" or "search," then select Thurston Geodata Center.
2. Thurston Geodata Center homepage appears. Click on Parcel Search.
3. Type in Street Number and Street Name OR type in the 11 digit parcel number. Click "Go."
4. A pop-up box appears with address and parcel number. Click on parcel number. Note: if more than 1 parcel number appears, click on the number with the most proper address (ave, rd, ln, SE, SW, etc.) and the first digit begins with 0-8. Parcel numbers beginning with 9 are not land parcels.
5. The data screen appears for the selected parcel. Click on "Zoom Map to Parcel."
6. A new window appears and the selected parcel now appears "highlighted" on the map. Use the buttons at the bottom of the window to navigate around the map, ie zoom in or out, pan around the area, identify other parcels, etc. (example: click on the OUT button, move cursor to highlighted parcel on map and click. A wider area view area appears). On the left side of the window, the square boxes to the left of the labels add additional layers to the map, ie aerial photos, contours, wetlands etc. – click on a box and the map will refresh itself with the new layer showing.
7. On the left side of the window, check the square box labeled Henderson Watershed under the hydro folder. This activates the Henderson Watershed Protection Area layer.
8. You can now determine if the selected parcel is IN or OUT of the watershed protection area. The blue-green shaded area is the HWPB.
9. If the parcel is bisected by the Henderson Watershed Protection Area (HWPB) boundary, you can determine if you are IN or OUT as follows:
 - Zoom IN until the parcel fills the map area. Click IN button on bottom of window then move cursor to highlighted parcel on map and click again. Repeat if necessary. (note: I personally like to remove the "Overview" from the map for better viewing – click on the "Overview" button at bottom of window to remove)
 - At the left of the window, check the square box labeled "2003 Aerial Photos" (near bottom left of window) and allow map to refresh.
 - The blue-green shaded area is the HWPB. If any structure with plumbing and/or if any part of the septic system is in or on the boundary for the HWPB, then the entire parcel is considered IN the watershed protection area Program.
