

**The Most Recent Change Since the Last Bulletin is:**

**In Thurston County, from the Pierce County line at the Nisqually River, north to Johnson Point is closed to all species of shellfish.**

*The following beaches are CLOSED to the recreational harvest of the species listed. All species means clams (including geoduck), oysters, mussels and other invertebrates such as the moon snail. All areas are closed for the sport harvest of scallops. The following closures do not apply to shrimp. Crabmeat is not known to contain the PSP toxin, but the guts can contain unsafe levels. To be safe, clean crab thoroughly and discard the guts (butter).*

**Clallam**

Seasonal closure of ocean beaches.  
The Strait of Juan de Fuca from the Jefferson County line westward to Cape Flattery.  
Dungeness Bay, Sequim Bay and Discovery Bay.

**Grays Harbor**

Seasonal closure of ocean beaches.

**Island**

Deception Pass including Cornet Bay.  
Ala Spit southeast to Strawberry Point.

**Jefferson**

Seasonal closure of ocean beaches.  
Discovery Bay, Port Townsend, Port Ludlow, Mats Mats Bay, Kilisut Harbor to include Mystery Bay and Admiralty Inlet from North Beach County Park, southeast to Kinney Point on south Marrowstone Island.

**King**

From Three Tree Point south to the Pierce County line and Quartermaster Harbor.

**Kitsap**

Point Jefferson south to South Beach on the southern side of Bainbridge Island including Agate Passage and Blake Island.

**Mason**

Hood Canal from Jorsted Creek south to the Narrows at Sisters Point.

**Pacific**

Seasonal closure of ocean beaches.

**Pierce**

Colvos Passage.  
The South Narrows from Day Island south to the Thurston County line.

**San Juan**

All of the County.

**Skagit**

All of the County.

**Snohomish**

Picnic Point south to the King County line.

**Thurston**

From the Pierce County line at the Nisqually River, north to Johnson Point.

**Whatcom**

All of the County.
