Over the past five years, an average of 77% of the produce harvested has been donated to the The Rainier Emergency Food Center which serves 200 families on a weekly basis and 2,100 individuals per month. The other 23% has been taken home by our volunteers who come to help during work parties. We have on average about 7 - 10 community volunteers who come to work parties or events.
