## **Four face pot, weapons charges after bust in Rochester**

Three family members and a fourth person face charges of possession of marijuana with intent to sell while armed after law officers found them with 22 pounds of marijuana and several firearms at a Rochester home Wednesday, according to the Thurston County Narcotics Task Force.

Welsey Roy Holmes, 31, of Centralia, Iris Beverly Holmes, 53, of Winlock, and Benjamin Robert Krogness, 31, of Centralia, were stopped by task force members while driving on Interstate 5 Wednesday afternoon near Maytown, task force supervisor Lt. Loreli Thompson said.

Five pounds of marijuana and two firearms were in the car, Thompson said.

Task force members served a search warrant for a home in the 8800 block of 183rd Avenue Southwest and found 17 pounds of marijuana and more firearms, Thompson said. Violet Ruth Dunivin, 62, who lists an address on 183rd Avenue Southwest, faces the same charges as the other three.

Thompson said arrests were prompted by information that the task force received about illegal drug sales. She said the task force continues to investigate.

The Holmeses and Dunivin are related; the exact relation isn't known, Thompson said.
