5. Update on the Henderson Inlet Community Shellfish Farm – Mark Fischer

  - a. These are student living in the Henderson Inlet watershed.
  - b. They can provide a large group of volunteers to do work such as planting vegetation in riparian and inter-tidal areas; perform surveys and monitoring.
  - c. First time with a focus on the Marine and salt water environment.
  - d. Mark will probably use the student in the Community Shellfish Farm.
  - e. March 6<sup>th</sup> water quality sampling occurs.
  - f. March 25<sup>th</sup> – the overall congress at Evergreen.
