Headline: Naked man assaults deputy

Details:

On November 29th at about 11:00 pm, Thurston County Deputies responded to a disturbance in the 2600 block of Wilderness Drive SE involving several intoxicated males. One of the males was threatening the others and refusing to leave. During the argument, the suspect male tore his own clothing off.

When Deputies arrived, the male suspect charged a TCSO patrol car and began hitting the patrol car with his head and fists. When the deputy exited his vehicle, the naked male charged him and a struggle ensued. The suspect was able to be brought under control only after multiple applications of a taser and being physically overpowered by the deputies. One deputy suffered minor injuries during the struggle.

Arrested for Assault 3rd Degree, assault on a law enforcement officer, was Sol N Grover, a 28 year old Olympia man. He is being held in the Thurston County Jail pending a probable cause hearing in Thurston County Superior Court.
