# Community Alert

**Date:** August 14, 2009

**Neighborhood/ Area:** Southeast Thurston County

**Nature of alert:** Malicious Mischief/Vandalism

**Details:** In the past week, Thurston County Sheriff's deputies have responded to several malicious mischief/vandalism complaints. The incidents have occurred in close proximity of each other.

Three rock throwing incidents occurred at the following locations: the 400 block of Trailblazer St. SE, the 6800 block of 4<sup>th</sup> Way, and Nisqually Middle School, which had approximately ten windows shattered. We have also had vandalism complaints at: 400 block of Kinwood St. SE, 300 block of Ranger Dr. SE, 400 block of Choker St. SE, and the 900 block of Neil St. SE.

Make your residence appear as if someone is home: leave a light or television on.

(You can also use timers)

Make sure your residence is secured.

Inform a neighbor if you are going to be away for the night or longer.

Note: All of the malicious mischief/vandalism complaints occurred in the hours of darkness.

Please report suspicious activity
