## Community Alert

**Date:** August 20, 2009

**Neighborhood/ Area:** Southwest Thurston County

**Nature of alert:** Burglary and Theft Complaints

**Details:** In the past three days, Thurston County Sheriff's deputies have responded to several thefts and a burglary complaint. The incidents have occurred in close proximity of each other.

Theft complaints at the 17,700 block of Pendelton and 10,300 block of HWY 12, Auto Theft at the 10,100 block HWY 12, Malicious Mischief/Property Damage at the 9,200 block of 178<sup>th</sup> Ave., and a Burglary at the 17,700 block of Littlerock Rd.

**Crime Prevention Tips:**

Leave blinds/curtains open

Make your residence appear as if someone is home: leave a light or television on.

(You can also use timers)

Make sure your residence is secured.

Inform a neighbor if you are going to be away for the night or longer.

If you have a monitored alarm system, make sure that the alarm company knows how to contact you. If your alarm is not monitored and is audible outside make sure your neighbors know how to contact you.

**Note:** Most all burglaries occur in the late morning to early afternoon hours (While we are at work)
