Sheriff's Office seeking dangerous felon

Attached are booking photographs of Curtis M. Sword, a white male adult, age 29, 5 Ft. 11 inches tall, 145 lbs. with black hair and brown eyes. There is Probable Cause for his arrest for Burglary in the 1st degree and Possession of Stolen Property 1st degree. Suspect Sword was positively identified as being responsible for a Residential Burglary in the 5500 blk. of 51st Ave. N.W. off Steamboat Island Rd. yesterday at 1150 hrs. The victim came home to find suspect Sword inside her bedroom placing items into a plastic bin. Suspect Sword ran out of the house and got into a black Mazda MX6 4door vehicle bearing WA plate 067WHW. This vehicle is a confirmed stolen out of the Lacey Police Department. Efforts to find Mr. Sword so far have been unsuccessful. Mr. Sword is also wanted by the Department of Corrections on a warrant for Escape from Community Custody. The Thurston County Sheriff's Office has also received information that Curtis Sword is in possession of a handgun. He is to be considered armed and dangerous.
