**Detectives seeking Wanted Burglary Suspect
from Gravelly Beach Rd. Burglary**

Detectives have identified one of the suspects who committed a residential burglary on 2/6/08 on Gravelly Bch Rd. N.W. and obtained a warrant for his arrest. He is Mitchell E. Coxwell, age 23, of Steamboat Island Rd. N.W. Mr. Coxwell is wanted for Theft of a Firearm and Residential Burglary. He is described as 5-8, 130 lbs., with short hair and blue eyes. Photo is attached.

He knows he is being sought but refuses to surrender himself. It is believed he is driving a stolen VW Passat, Blue in color, Washington License, 642 RMC. The vehicle is supposed to have ground effects and possibly a rear spoiler. The investigation has recovered 5 stolen guns, one stolen vehicle that was used in the burglary, and several other items belonging to our victim. Detectives believe the suspect is still in the Mason/Thurston county area.
