



REDUCE REUSE RECYCLE

PAPER, PLASTIC AND METALS



Paper



Newspapers



Phone books



Books (remove covers and binding from hardcover books)



Cereal and food boxes



Milk and juice cartons



Shoe boxes



Office paper



Cardboard (flattened)



Paper bags



Magazines, catalogs, and mail (no need to remove labels, staples, envelope windows, or sticky notes)

Plastic



Plastic bottles, jugs, and jars (neck must be narrower than the base)



Plastic buckets (clean, no lids or handles)



Rigid plastic plant pots (empty, no dirt)



Dairy tubs and yogurt cups

Metal



Pots and pans



Aluminum and tin cans (including #10 cans)

No shredded paper, glass bottles, window or mirror glass, lids or caps, plastic bags, or garbage.

Contact your hauler with billing, service level, or collection schedule questions. Ask about cost-effective services like shredding, glass collection, organics collection, bulky item pick-up, and separate collection for larger quantities of cardboard or office paper.
