Recycle Collection Days for Curbside Customers

Your Recycle Days At a Glance

This flyer lists recycling pick-up dates and information for 2012. Keep the collection schedule on the back page handy for future reference. You can also download this flyer on the "Publications" page of www.ThurstonSolidWaste.org.

Cart Placement

Put your cart out by 6 a.m. on pick-up days. Place your cart at the curb or within 3 feet from the road, with the opening of the cart facing the street or alley. Your cart should be at least 3 feet away from basketball hoops, trees, mailboxes, or other containers. Place the cart 5 feet away from vehicles.



Allow 18 feet of space above the cart to make room for the truck's robotic arm.

Recycle Glass Correctly

You must put glass in a separate, rigid container, between 5 and 20 gallons in size. Those old plastic kitty litter and detergent buckets work well, provided they're at least 5 gallons and you remove the lids. Remember to drill enough drain holes in the bottom – if rainwater collects in your container, the driver cannot take your glass. Glass is collected every other recycle day and you can set out more than one container.



Recycle Right

Recycling is a great way to reduce trash disposal costs, conserve resources, and cut down on the amount of waste going to the landfill. Do YOUR part and recycle the right way – it's easy!

- Be sure items are recyclable before putting them in your cart.
- Recyclables must be free of food waste and other contaminants.
- Put glass in a separate container.

If you are unsure which items go in your recycle cart, the rule of thumb is "when in doubt, leave it out." When recyclables are contaminated with other materials, the processing costs increase. The result is a more expensive recycling program and a lower commodity credit (rebate) on your bill.

RECYCLE – Picked up every TWO weeks

- If you are an "A," set out your recycle bin on ALL yellow weeks.
- If you are a "B," set out your recycle bin on ALL blue weeks.

GLASS – Picked up every FOUR weeks alongside the recycle bin.

- If you are an "A1," set glass out A1 weeks.
- If you are an "A2," set glass out A2 weeks.
- If you are an "B1," set glass out B1 weeks.
- If you are an "B2," set glass out B2 weeks.
