To Complete the Conservation Program Application (CCC-1202) and the Appendix (CCC-1202)

1. Fill out the name, address, telephone number, location, and county and state on the upper portion of the first page.
2. Answer questions 2 - 11 and sign and date. **Do not to forget to put in your tax identification number.**
3. Please read page 1 - 10 of the Appendix and sign and date it.
4. Note, if there are more than one person owns the land and no one has power of attorney then each owner must sign both the application and the appendix. In the event that the land is leased, both the owner(s) and operator(s) must sign unless one has power of attorney.
5. You are done with the application. Additional forms will need to be completed as soon as we receive your application and you are encouraged to submit your application as soon as possible.
