Do not cut or alter the shape or size of your ballot.

RAINIER SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 307
PROPOSITION NO. 1
GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS

The Board of Directors of Rainier School District No. 307 passed Resolution No. 193 concerning a proposition to issue general obligation bonds. This proposition authorizes the District to expand and modernize Rainier Middle School and Rainier Elementary School; construct and equip new facilities at Rainier High School, and make other capital improvements, to pay for such projects by issuing \$8,045,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within a maximum of 21 years, and to levy property taxes annually, in addition to regular taxes, to repay such bonds, all as provided in Resolution No. 193.
