 Maintenance and Operation Levy

The Board of Directors of Rochester School District No. 401 adopted Resolution No. 09-07 concerning a proposition to levy property taxes. Upon the expiration of the current maintenance and operation levy, the proposition would authorize the following taxes for purposes of operation and maintenance in excess of all regular property tax levies, upon all taxable property within Rochester School District No. 401 for the District's general fund:
