#### **How To Mark Your Ballot**

To vote, completely fill in the oval "  " to the left of your desired response.

Use a black or blue ink pen.

Do not use a pencil or gel pen.


In each contest, vote for one candidate.

More than one vote for an office or ballot measure will be an overvote, and no votes for that office or ballot measure will be counted.

#### **How To Correct Your Ballot**

Do not erase any selection made in error.

\*If you make a mistake, draw a line through the entire candidate's name:

 ~~Candidate Name~~

If you wish to vote for another candidate, fill in the oval to the left of your chosen candidate.

Signatures, comments, or identifying marks on the ballot may invalidate your ballot. Do not cut or alter the shape or size of your ballot.

If needed, you may request a replacement ballot by contacting the Thurston County Auditor's Office at (360) 786-5408.

#### **Write-in Votes**

To vote for a person not on the ballot, write the name on the line provided for that office, then completely fill in the oval to the left of the write-in line.

#### **Return Your Ballot**

Follow the instructions on your envelopes and the yellow insert.

Remember to sign and date the voter's affidavit on the mailing envelope.

**READ:** Each candidate for partisan office may state a political party that he or she prefers. A candidate’s preference does not imply that the candidate is nominated or endorsed by the party, or that the party approves of or associates with that candidate.

**City of Olympia  
Proposition No. 1  
Fire Department Acquisition and Improvement Bonds - \$16,500,000**

The City Council of the City of Olympia passed Ordinance No. 6554 concerning this proposition. This proposition authorizes the City to construct and equip a new fire station and a fire training center and acquire two fire engines and a ladder truck, issue general obligation bonds in the principal amount of \$16,500,000, maturing within a maximum of twenty years from date of issue, and levy property taxes annually in addition to regular tax levies to repay such bonds, all as provided in Ordinance No. 6554.

**Fire Protection District No. 1 – Grand Mound - Rochester

Levy Lid Lift**

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 1, Thurston County, Washington, (Grand Mound - Rochester Fire) adopted Resolution No. 2008-01 concerning a proposition to restore the District's regular property tax levy. The proposition would authorize the District to restore its regular property tax levy to an amount not to exceed \$1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed value for collection in 2009 for maintenance, and operations costs. The levy amount will be used to calculate subsequent levy limits.

**Fire Protection District No. 3 - Lacey  
Proposition No. 1  
Levy Lid Lift**

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 3, Thurston County, Washington, (Lacey Fire District 3) adopted Resolution No. 788-05-08 concerning a proposition to restore the District’s regular property tax levy. The proposition would authorize the District to restore its regular property tax levy to an amount not to exceed \$1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed value for collection in 2009 to pay increases in operational costs, and set the limit factor at 100% plus the annual percentage change in the Consumer Price Index (as identified in the Resolution) for each of the five succeeding years (2010 – 2014). The 2014 levy amount will be used to calculate subsequent levy limits.
