Sample Ballot Instructions

How To Mark Your Ballot

To vote, completely fill in the oval to the left of your desired response.

- Use a dark ink pen.
- Do not use a pencil or gel pen.

More than one vote for a ballot measure will be an overvote, and no votes for that ballot measure will be counted.

How To Correct Your Ballot

Do not erase any selection made in error.

If you make a mistake, mark an "X" through the incorrectly marked oval and fill in the oval to the left of the correct response.

Signatures, comments, or identifying marks on the ballot may invalidate your ballot. Do not cut or alter the shape or size of your ballot.

North Thurston Public Schools Proposition No. 1 Maintenance and Operation Levy

The Board of Directors of North Thurston Public Schools adopted Resolution No. 750 concerning a proposition to levy property taxes. Upon the expiration of the current maintenance and operation levy, the proposition would authorize the following taxes in excess of all regular property tax levies, upon all taxable property within the District for the District's general fund for purposes of operation and maintenance, including teaching, school supplies, athletics and activities, transportation and facilities maintenance:
