This February Special Election is nearly County-Wide, with 294 out of 297 precincts participating. Precincts 030, 031, and 130 are not participating in this election.

#### **Election Result Information**

On Election Day, the Logic and Accuracy test will begin at 8:30 a.m. followed by the first count of ballots, with a second count in the late afternoon. Printouts of election results will be available Election Night shortly after 8:00 p.m. with the first release of results.

Additional counts will be conducted daily beginning at 4:00 p.m. (weekends and holidays excluded) as required by law.

Updated results will be available each day after all processed ballots have been counted. Daily tabulation may be postponed if the Auditor's Office is not in possession of at least 500 valid, processed ballots at the scheduled time.

The final certification will be February 24, at 4:30 p.m.

School District levies and RFSPA measures require a simple majority to pass (50% +1).

Creation of Regional Fire Protection Service Authority

The Regional Fire Protection Service Authority Planning Committee has submitted to the City of Yelm, Yelm Fire District #2 and Thurston County Fire District #4 (Rainier) a Regional Fire Service Protection Authority Plan to create and fund a Regional Fire Protection Service Authority under RCW 52.26. If this Plan is approved, it will create a regional authority for fire protection and emergency medical services funded by a regular property tax, not to exceed \$1.50 per one thousand dollars of assessed value.
