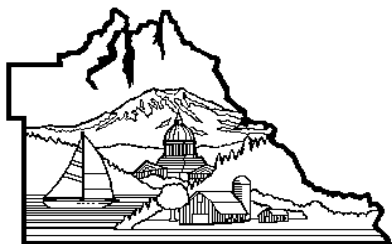

HOW TO PETITION TO END DOMESTIC PARTNERSHIP

CHECKLIST

Use the forms and instructions in this packet only if the following factors apply to your situation:

- ✓ You are seeking to end a domestic partnership that was registered with the Secretary of State.
- ✓ One of the parties resides in Washington State.
- ✓ There are no dependent children of this domestic partnership.
- ✓ The parties are not signing the papers together and are not in agreement.

PLEASE NOTE: If you need property divided, debts divided, or any other issues taken care of on a temporary basis while your dissolution action is pending, there are separate packets available for:

Motion for Temporary Orders
Immediate Restraining Order

READ ME: It is very important for you to know that when you sign a court document, you may be helping or hurting your court case. Before you sign any court document or get involved with a court case, it is important that you carefully read the document to make sure you are doing the right thing. You may also want to contact a lawyer for legal advice and help with those issues you do not understand. The Self-Help Center has a list of local attorneys who can help you on a task-by-task basis for a fee. If you need help with the forms, procedures and rules of the court, there is a Family Court Facilitator available to assist you.
