

Thurston County

Veterans Assistance Program

The county fund is an emergency fund for past due basic living expenses. Currently for a veteran with family the maximum amount we assist with is up to \$4000 and \$2000 for single veterans. There is an income limit per household size. The veteran must have an honorable or general under honorable conditions for discharge serving at least 180 days of active duty service, excluding training. Additional requirements are residency requirements of being a Washington state resident for at least 6 months and living in Thurston County for 31 days.

Please contact Ashley Redlevske at the Lacey Veterans Hub by email or phone for more information. The following documents will be required per our policy and procedures, in addition to a signed application when applying for assistance. It takes 7-10 business days for processing applications.

- DD 214, COPY 2 or 4
- Identification
- DSHS Benefits* (*Food benefits*)
- Marriage Certificate*
- Birth Certificate* (*For children under 18 in the home*)
- Income Verification-ALL FORMS OF INCOME (i.e. cash app, venmo, child support, TANF, social security, disability, VA disability, etc.)
- ALL** bank statements **AND** savings accounts or Direct Express Statements, cash app statements for **ALL** adults in the home for **last 2 Months**.
- Lease Agreement
- Past Due Bill
- Residency Verification-WA ID or Utility Bill
- Death Certificate of Veteran*
- Car insurance and title/registration for car repair assistance * ****(if applicable)***
