Requires 60% participation based on assessed value of all properties within proposed annexation area.

**TO THE HONORABLE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YELM,
WASHINGTON, P.O. Box 479, Yelm, WA 98597.**

We, the undersigned, being the owners of not less than sixty percent (60%) in assessed value, of the real property herein described, do hereby petition that such territory be annexed to and made a part of the City of Yelm.*

The territory proposed to be annexed is within Thurston County, Washington. A description of the property and a map that outlines the boundaries of the property as more particularly described in Exhibit A is attached.

The City Council of the City of Yelm met with the initiating parties at a Council meeting on April 10, 2007 and did determine that the City would accept the proposed annexation. At said meeting, the City Council did also determine that:

- It would require the simultaneous adoption of a comprehensive plan for the area to be annexed; and
- It would require the assumption of existing City indebtedness by the area to be annexed,

as disclosed by the minute entry regarding the same in the minutes of said Council meeting.
