Dear Ms. Kisielius, Mr. Mann, Mr. Fancher, and Mr. Smith:

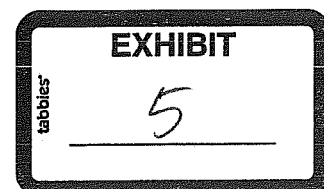
A prehearing conference was held in this matter on February 1, 2012. Those participating were Laura Kisielius, attorney for the Applicant; David Mann, attorney for the Association for the Protection of Hammersley, Eld and Totten Inlets (APHETI); Jeff Fancher, Deputy Prosecuting Attorney for Thurston County; Robert Smith, Senior Planner for Thurston County; Hearing Examiner Clerk Cami Petersen; and Hearing Examiner Tom Bjorgen.

The e-mail sent January 30, 2012 from the Hearing Examiner to Ms. Kisielius, Mr. Mann, Mr. Fancher and Mr. Smith sets out the legal basis for holding this conference and the restrictions needed to ensure that it does not affect any procedural or substantive rights of persons who may subsequently attain party status. That e-mail is incorporated into this document by reference.

At the conference the Applicant, APHETI and the County discussed legal issues which may be raised in this proceeding. These persons also projected the number of witnesses they might call and identified, by subject matter or name, expert witnesses they might call. These projections do not preclude the calling of other witnesses. However, the Applicant, APHETI and the County are under a continuing duty to advise each other of the name and subject matter of any additional expert witnesses each plans to call at the time the party knows it plans to call such witnesses.

Prehearing briefs will not be submitted. At or near the close of the hearing, the Examiner will hear from all parties whether closing argument or post-hearing briefing will be submitted.
