Following a request for reconsideration that included a request to supplement the record in the above-captioned permit decisions, an order reopening the record was issued on December 23, 2019. That order established a submission schedule allowing the Applicant to submit additional specific evidence and argument supporting a modified (reduced) proposal as proposed in the reconsideration, a County response, and an Appellant reply to the County response.

Following the Appellant's initial submission of additional evidence, which included the modified proposal, the County's submittal essentially declined to review the new evidence for compliance with County regulations. In the absence of County response to the new evidence, the undersigned is left with unanswered questions.

Therefore the hearing will be reconvened at the earliest available regularly scheduled hearing calendar at which all necessary parties are available. The Hearing Examiner Clerk will coordinate communications leading to identification of the reconvened hearing date.

At the reconvened hearing, testimony will be limited as follows:

- Applicant witnesses will speak to the proposed project revisions and address how the record as a whole demonstrates compliance with criteria for approval.
- County witnesses will respond to the revised proposal and testify as to the County's position of whether the record as a whole as to whether criteria for approval are shown to be satisfied.
- Applicant witnesses, as always, will have the right of response.

There will not be additional public comment. However, the hearing will be noticed as required by County Code and open to all.
