**Headline:** Grand Mound Home Invasion – Suspects Arrested

Details: TCSO deputies were dispatched to a reported armed home invasion last night around 7:30 pm in the 6300 block of 198<sup>th</sup> Trail SW in the Grand Mound area. A neighbor reported seeing 2 armed men trying to force their way into a residence. While enroute to the scene, deputies were advised by the witnesses that the armed men were now fleeing the residence and provided a vehicle description and that the suspects had fled south on Old Hwy 99. The vehicle was stopped a short time later by WSP in Centralia and were assisted by Centralia PD and LCSO.

Deputies and detectives learned that the two armed men forced their way into the residence. The residents of that house were currently not home, but they had two people in the residence that were housesitting at the time of the home invasion. The two in the house were able to flee from the residence and were not injured. The suspects fired a shot while inside the house, but no one was hit.

The two suspects and a third get a way driver were all arrested and booked into TCSO jail for Burglary 1<sup>st</sup> degree and Assault 1<sup>st</sup> degree. The three suspects were a 37-year-old male, 35-year-old male, and 30-year-old male from the Thurston County area.
