



1st Quarter 2010 Gang Report

Graffiti Reports:

TCSO Online Report #10-200012 / Malicious Mischief 1st Degree:

TCSO received online report of alleged gang graffiti spray painted on back of victim vehicle. The words "BTM" in black temporary paint were drawn on the victim's vehicle. Incident could have occurred while victim was in Seattle. Seattle Gang Task Force identifies "BTM" as "Big Time Mafia". The group is known as a tagging crew that will fight other tagging crews.

Malicious Mischief / Golden Eagle Loop SE:

Citizen reported that a red swastika was painted on his garage. Victim is not of Jewish descent and it is unknown why he was targeted. No suspect information at this time.

Cad Report from Patrol on Peregrine Loop SE:

Citizen report of gang graffiti spray painted on the above listed address that has occurred within the past several days. No known gang activity at address reported by law enforcement.

TCSO Case #10-528 / Malicious Mischief // Gang graffiti:

TCSO responded to 57th Dr SE for alleged gang graffiti spray painted on mailboxes with the number "13" and the phrase "Im those police are dead". The citizen also reported that there has been an increase in vehicle prowls and vehicles being spray painted with graffiti. No suspect information at this time.

TCSO Case# 10-678 / Malicious Mischief / Burglary / Hoss Field :

On 02/07/10 TCSO took a report from Hoss Field off 196th Avenue SW, Rochester reference burglary and vandalism to property within. The alleged suspects spray painted gang related profanities. Alleged suspects may be juveniles from the area.

TCSO Case#10-832 / Malicious Mischief / Juvenile referred for charges:

TCSO responded to Martin Way for gang graffiti incident in a trailer park. A male juvenile was referred for Malicious Mischief 3rd Degree for spray painting "SS 4-ever" (meaning South Side 4-Ever) in blue on the back of several of the trailers. He stated to the deputy he was bored and decided to spray paint the other tenants dwellings. The case was referred to the Juvenile P/A Office.

TCSO Case# 200233 Online Report reference Graffiti on NE Friendly Grove:

On 03/09/10 at approximately 1000 hours, TCSO received an online report reference graffiti on a commercial building that had since been removed. No additional information provided. Victim reported that the tagging occurred in late February.

TCSO Case# 10-1250 Malicious Mischief / Mottman Road SW:

On 03/04/10 at approximately 1030 hours, TCSO took a report of graffiti spray painted in orange on the new county facility building. Not gang-related, more tag-type graffiti. County is working to remove all graffiti from the building. No suspect information.

TCSO Case# 10-1462 Malicious Mischief / Mottman Road SW:

On 03/25/10, TCSO took another graffiti report on the building. No suspect information.

Gang Related Incidents:

TCSO Case #10-0002 / Assault 1st Degree w/Deadly Weapon:

On 01/01/10 at approximately 0000 hours, TCSO Deputies responded to a juvenile disturbance involving an alleged stabbing on Old Hwy 99 SE. The incident involved two alleged juveniles involved in gang activity. Suspect claims to be an "88-boys Crip" out of Tumwater. (Gang allegedly named after 88th Avenue SE off Old Hwy 99 where several of the members live). The victim is claiming to be "Squaxin Island Nation Crip." The alleged incident was over loyalty to the "True Blue Crip Gang." This case is under investigation. Suspect was arrested on this incident for Assault 1st Degree with Deadly Weapon.

TCSO Case #10-292 / Disturbance /Gang members vowing justice for David Mapu

(USO / United Samoan Organization)

TCSO responded to Edelweiss Lane and Lucerne Lane for a verbal disturbance involving alleged Samoan gang member, intoxicated and upset over the recent murder of David Mapu. He was making statements that the incident was not resolved and justice will be taken.

TCSO Case #10-399 / Assault 1st / Unlawful Possession Short Barrel Shotgun:

TCSO arrested subject for discharging a firearm several times in dispute with neighbor. Several firearms were removed from residence to include a short barreled shotgun. Subject was arrested for Assault 1st Degree and Unlawful Possession of Short Barrel Shotgun. Lakewood Gang Unit is currently investigating subject on a separate matter.

TCSO Case# 10- 569 / Assault 2nd arrest on Freedom Ln:

TCSO arrested subject for Assault 2nd Degree. He is an associate with the "Fam-Bam Gang" currently in custody in TCSO jail.

TCSO Case #10-612 / Violation Protection Order D/V (DOC /Escapee):

(LVL Gang Member) Suspect was arrested in Centralia and is currently in custody on warrant and new charges.

Currently in custody on Doc escape warrant. Charged for three counts of violation protection order by TCSO. On 03/21/10, TCSO received report that the suspect was making threats to kill again. He was arrested for a DOC warrant and auto theft out of Lewis County.

TCSO Case# 10-668 / Burglary / Scatterview Lane SW:

On 02/05/10 TCSO took a burglary report from victim(s) alleging that their barn was broken into and that the boyfriend of a neighboring address may have been involved in attempting to steal the security equipment.

TCSO Case # 10-871 / Assault Gang related:

TCSO responded to an assault incident involving a firearm and knife. The victim was unlawfully imprisoned at a Yelm Creek address at gun point and accused of being a "snitch". He was hit on the head with a semi-auto pistol and told that he was going to have "three bullets put in him". He was further assaulted by the alleged suspects

and he claimed that he begged the subjects to let him go. When he was leaving the scene in his car one of the alleged suspect's shattered the back window of his vehicle with a knife. The victim stated that his alleged assailants were members of the "Native Gangster Bloods".

On 02/26/10 at approximately 1700 hours male suspect was arrested on his warrant. Another subject was arrested for Robbery 1st Degree. All alleged suspects were interviewed and a confession gained from one suspect that he robbed the alleged victim for drugs and then threatened the victim with a large knife. All suspects have affiliation with "Native Gangster Bloods".

TCSO Case #10-906 / Telephone Harassment/threats to kill:

Subject was recently released from prison and made several death threats towards individuals that he was going to kill them. He is classified by the Department of Corrections as a "Florescia" affiliate while in prison. He is an extremely violent person that has bragged about killing people in the past. He is currently in custody in our jail.

TCSO Case# 10-1157 / Gang Related Assault Referral:

On 03/08/10 TCSO responded for an assault involving rival gang members. Two juveniles got into a physical fight over being involved in rival gangs. One **claims to be a** "Norteno" assaulted another claiming to be a "Sureno" while being transferred to different units in the facility. Case referred to Juvenile P/A.

TCSO Case# 10-1171 / Assault Gang Related:

On 03/08/10 TCSO responded to a gang related fight involving a juvenile victim being transported to St. Peters Hospital for serious facial injuries. The victim was uncooperative at that time, but did identify that he was assaulted by at least six members of the "Fam-Bam Gang". Upon further investigation it has been determined that the assault was reference a dispute over a relationship with a juvenile female. The involved subjects claim no status in any gang activity. The case has been suspended.

TCSO Case#10-1314 / Auto Theft / Juvenile Gang affiliation:

On 03/16/10 at approximately 2100 hours, TCSO responded to Yelm Hwy SE for an auto theft complaint. Juvenile was taken into custody for taking motor vehicle w/o permission. He had "Folk Nation" graffiti on several items in his room. He self-admitted that he used to be associated with the gang and pretended to be a drug dealer.

TCSO Case #10-1363 / Martin Way E / Theft of wire and Graffiti:

On 03/19/10 at approximately 0915 hours, TCSO took a report from a business reference theft of wire from back up generator were cut and taken. Suspected graffiti was spray painted on the back door. No suspect information at this time.

A new development for this quarter is a more proactive response to the Gang problem occurring in the Maple Lane Juvenile Detention facility. A lot of gang members from throughout the State are sent to that facility to complete their time and after discussions with Maple Lane Administrators, our office is taken a stronger stance on “gang related assaults” in the Maple Lane School. We have already begun seeing an increase in these types of referrals and anticipate an initial rise in filings with the obvious hope that a quick and swift response to gang assaults will have a chilling effect on that type of behavior in the very near future.
