Headline: Registered Sex Offenders Reach 800 in Thurston County

Details: TCSO has now exceeded 800 registered sex offenders living in Thurston County. Sex offender levels are determined by taking into account several factors about the offender and the nature of his or her crime in order to determine possible risks to the community at large.

Level I: offender whose risk assessment and other factors indicate they are a low risk to sexually reoffend within the community at large. Level I offenders are not published on the Washington State Sex Offender Registry. However, out of compliance and transient level I offenders are published.

Level II: offender whose risk assessment and other factors indicate they are a moderate risk to sexually reoffend within the community at large. Level II offenders are published on the Washington State Sex offender Website.

Level III: offender whose risk assessment and other factors indicate they are a high risk to sexually reoffend within the community at large. Level III offenders are published on the Washington State Sex offender Website

Thurston County Sheriff's Office numbers as of August 1, 2019 are as follows:

Level I = 613 offenders registered + 47 transient (no home associated with offender)

Level II = 82 offenders registered + 18 transient (no home associated with offender)

Level III = 33 offenders registered + 9 transient (no home associated with offender)

Total number of registered sex offenders in Thurston County are **802** with **74** being transient. Of the **74** transient offenders approximately **90%** typically reside within city jurisdictions.
