Rate Guide

All transactions are rounded to the nearest dollar.

Customers are charged for a minimum of 1 cubic yard – 1 cubic yard is equal to a box 3 feet wide, by 3 feet high, by 3 feet deep.

Household garbage, yard waste, non-refrigerated appliances, vehicle tires

\$18.00 per cubic yard

Limit of 5 tires per customer per day

Construction & demolition debris

\$31.00 per cubic yard

Lumber, building scraps, rubble, broken concrete, bricks, plaster, sheetrock, conduit, pipe, flooring, fencing, decking, wire, insulation, etc.

Roofing debris

\$48.00 per cubic yard

Asphalt and wood shingles, metal roofing, etc.



Holidays

Both drop-box facilities and the Waste and Recovery Center are closed July 4, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.

Helpful Reminders

- Remember to cover your load. Washington State Law requires that all loads be secured.
- **Free recycling** is available at all facilities for newspapers, mixed paper, plastic bottles, aluminum and tin cans, dairy tubs, yogurt cups, and rigid plant pots and buckets. Sort cardboard and glass bottles/jars into separate bins.

Items not accepted at drop-box facilities

- Asbestos
- Refrigerated appliances
- Computers, monitors, laptops, tablets, TVs, DVD players, and e-readers. Please take these items to the recycling center at the Waste and Recovery Center. They will be recycled for free as part of Washington's E-Cycle program.
