Rate guide

All transactions are rounded to the nearest dollar.

Customers are charged for a minimum of 1 cubic yard – 1 cubic yard is equal to a box 3 feet wide, by 3 feet high, by 3 feet deep.

Household garbage, yard waste, non-refrigerated appliances, vehicle tires

\$18 per cubic yard

Limit of 5 tires per customer per day and must be less than 36 inches.

Construction and demolition debris

\$31 per cubic yard

Lumber, building scraps, rubble, broken concrete, bricks, plaster, sheetrock, conduit, pipe, flooring, fencing, decking, wire, insulation, etc.

Roofing debris

\$48 per cubic yard

Asphalt and wood shingles, metal roofing, etc.

Holidays

All Solid Waste facilities are closed New Year's Day, July 4, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. Open on all other holidays.

Cover your load

Washington State law requires that all loads be secured.

Recycling

Accepted for free at all facilities:

- Mixed paper; aluminum and tin cans; plastic bottles, jugs, jars, dairy tubs, yogurt cups, and buckets
- Corrugated cardboard
- Glass bottles and jars
- Motor oil and filters
- Automotive batteries

Not accepted at drop-box facilities:

- Asbestos
- Refrigerated appliances
- TVs and monitors. Take these to participating E-Cycle Washington drop-off locations for free. For a list of locations, call 1-800-RECYCLE or visit ecyclewashington.org.
